HEAR FROM CRYSTOL THOMAS- ECONOMIC ASSISTANT SPEACIALIST WITH TEXAS A&M AGRILIFE:

Crystol Thomas, Economic Development Assistant Specialist with the **Texas A&M Agrilife Extension Service**, appeared before the Court to discuss economic development opportunities for Lipscomb County as a rural community. Ms. Thomas presented strategic options for fostering growth and expanding the county's economic potential. She discussed the possibility of transitioning from the current Economic Development Corporation (EDC) model serving the City of Booker to establishing a county-wide Lipscomb County Economic Development Corporation. Ms. Thomas outlined how such a transition could provide broader opportunities for development, support long-term planning, and create options for expanding Lipscomb County's tax base through targeted economic growth initiatives. The Court received the information and engaged in discussion regarding potential future opportunities for county-wide economic development.
