**ORDER [PROHIBITING OR RESTRICTING] CERTAIN FIREWORKS  
 IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF LIPSCOMB COUNTY, TEXAS**

WHEREAS, the Texas Forest Service has determined that drought conditions exist in Lipscomb County; and

WHEREAS, on the 12<sup>th</sup> of December, 2022, Commissioners Court of Lipscomb County has determined that the normal danger of fire in the unincorporated areas of Lipscomb County is greatly enhanced by the extremely dry conditions now existing;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Lipscomb County adopts this Order [prohibiting OR restricting] the sale or use of restricted fireworks in the unincorporated areas of Lipscomb County.

- A. A person may not sell, detonate, ignite, or in any way use fireworks classified as “skyrockets with sticks” under 49 C.F.R. part. 173.100(r)(2) (10-01-86 edition) or missiles with fins in any portion of the unincorporated areas of Lipscomb County.
- B. [Describe specific restrictions, if applicable.]
- C. This Order does not prohibit “permissible firework” as authorized in Occupations Code Section 2154.003(a).
- D. A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or intentionally violates a prohibition established by this Order. An offense under this order is a Class C. Misdemeanor.
- E. This order expires on the date the Texas Forest Service determines drought conditions no longer exist in the county or January 1, 2023.
